# Project Participating in Government

### The Task

Your "Party" will prepare a Group Paper, Portfolio and brief Presentation on a designated political party. Your group should select a chairperson (through election) that will coordinate and delegate jobs to complete the project.

### **Group Paper**

- **JOB 1:** Write a brief (300 words) historical background on your party.
- **JOB 2**: n a paragraph (100 word minimum), describe in general terms what your party's philosophy is regarding the role of government in American life. Find a current or past campaign slogan used by your political party.
- **JOB 3:** Choose two major issues and describe your party's position. Be sure to explain how your party justifies its position.
- The paper needs to be typed (12 pt font) and appropriately referenced.

<u>Portfolio</u>: You will also create a Political Party Portfolio with the following evidence below. You will staple your paper and collection of evidence above in the order listed to complete your portfolio. Your portfolio needs a cover page with a title and the names of all group members.

- o **JOB 4**: Find a photo of, draw, or trace a famous person from your party (1950-present) and include a significant quote from that person regarding their political stance.
- JOB 5: Create an original political cartoon which reflects your party's position on one of the following policy issues: role of government, economy, foreign policy, education, immigration, entitlements
- o **JOB 6**: Compile a list of interest groups or well-known companies that align politically and/or have contributed/campaigned for members in this party.
- o **JOB** 7: Get a CA voter registration form and create a "How to Guide" for voter registration in CA.
- O JOB 8: Create an Electoral Map and plan an electoral strategy to get your presidential candidate elected in the electoral college in 2020.
- o **JOB 9:** Content Terms...learn all the content terminology associated with this project/unit. Learn terms, teach group, and be prepared to take a quiz on the terms as a group.
  - \*\*All group members will need to know terminology for Final Exam.\*\*

**Presentation:** Do a 5 minute presentation for the class explaining your party platform and a brief summary of the evidence you collected for your portfolio.

You will staple your paper and collection of evidence above in the order listed to complete your portfolio. Your portfolio needs a cover page with a title and the names of all group members.

# The Process

- Divide the work up as evenly as possible. You MUST research the views of the political party through the Internet, reading magazines, and watching/listening to interviews on radio and TV. Be AWARE of political bias! ©
- You will have 3 in class work days.
- Make sure your paper is proofread and that your portfolio is organized and is pleasing to the eye.
- Practice your presentation before you present.

# Grading

• Students grades will be based on the group overall grade. However, grades can be lowered or raised from teacher observation and party chairperson input.
